According to this agency's responsibilities under Section 163.3184(3)(b) *Florida Statutes*, we reviewed the above document to determine if proposed amendments may adversely impact significant historic resources.

We note that Standards 4 and 8 of the Staff Report adequately address historic resource concerns and proposed solutions. Our office concurs with the recommendations of a 250 ft. buffer in mining areas adjacent to the historic cemetery and a cultural resource assessment survey of the project area to locate and evaluate archaeological and historical resources.
